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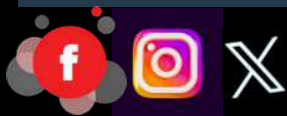

August 13, 2026

The five members of our Governing Board -- three from Whittier Union High School District and two from El Rancho Unified School District -- join together on the second Thursday of each month to attend our monthly Board Meetings. The main purpose of the meetings is to consider and possibly take action on items placed on the monthly meeting agenda. (And, although it's Summer break for most in the education arena, our Board Members continue to meet.) The following is a quick peek at what took place during the August 2026 Board Meeting:

*The Board approved the attendance of Dr. John Smith, Superintendent, at the CAROCP State Board Meeting, September 24, 2026, in Anaheim.

*The Board approved the attendance of Dr. John Smith, Superintendent, and Kathi Kent, Director of Educational Services, at the CAROCP State Board Meeting and CTE Conference, November 16-21, 2026, in Rancho Mirage.

*The Board approved the following new courses of study for the 2026/2027 school year:

1. Veterinary Assistant I

3. Mental Health Careers

*The Board approved the MOUs between Tri-Cities ROP and El Rancho Unified and Whittier Union High School District regarding pass-through funding for the 2026-2027 school year.

*The Board approved the annual member contribution for the Whittier Area Liability and Property Self-Insurance Authority for the 2026-2027 school year.

*The Board approved an Amendment to the contract with the Los Angeles County Office of Education regarding Employee on Loan Reimbursement, Division of Technology Services - BEST Project.

*The Board approved the renewal of the subscription with Major Metropolitan Security for alarm system monitoring for the ROP offices and the Dental classroom/lab for the 2026-2027 school year.

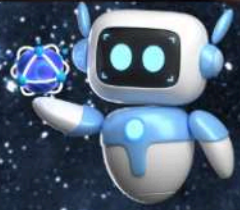
